PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Williams Road Safe Street Corridor Project is focused on improving safety and access for people walking, biking, driving, and otherwise traveling in the project area. The project improvements were derived from the City's Vision Zero Action Plan and Active Transportation Plan efforts. The project is funded through the Active Transportation Program (ATP) and Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) funds.

PROJECT LOCATION

The project corridor extends along Williams Road from Alisal / John Street to Freedom Parkway. This corridor serves as the main thoroughfare for the Alisal community and connects residents to schools, libraries, a fire station, shopping centers, and other local businesses.
